Restoration of City Hall Windows:

Chairman Torre addressed the Board and Staff in regards to allocating funds to restore the windows at City Hall in the City's budget. He stated his belief of funds possibility being available in the City's budget for the restoration and repair of the windows but was not certain. He suggested that a motion be made by the Board to have Staff return to the Board with an official word from the Finance Department with clarification as to where the funding is for the next Historic Preservation Board meeting. However, if it was found that funding did not exist then a motion is to be created to have the item be placed in the City's budget for the coming fiscal year for the purposes of starting on the restoration process of the windows.

On the advice of Deputy City Attorney Ramos, Chair Torre passed the gavel to Vice-Chair Silva.

A motion was made by Mr. Torre to have Staff provide a report at the next Historic Preservation Board meeting as to the location of funding in the City's budget for the restoration of the windows in City Hall and if funding was not available, an item to be placed in the City's budget for the coming fiscal year as a line item. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fullerton and was unanimously approved by voice vote.
