It is with great pleasure that I nominate Officers Wright and Johnson for the distinguished Officer of the Month Award. Documented below is the incident that generated this memo.

On June 26, 2017, at 6:53 p.m., Officers Wright, Johnson and Delgado were dispatched to 9345 Balada Street reference a burglary in progress where an unknown black male was inside the residence.

Upon their arrival, Officers made contact with the house keeper who stated that she was inside the residence when she observed an unknown black male walking out of the home theater room. She attempted to ask him what he was doing, and he instantaneously ran outside using a glass sliding door to the pool patio. The unknown black male then ran south through the back yard. Immediately a BOLO was issued for a 25 year old black male, wearing a dark tee shirt with green long shorts.

Officers Wright and Johnson proceeded to check the area where the Offender was last seen. Both Officers located the black male hiding in the bushes on the south side of 9375 Balada St., three houses south from 9345. Officers Wright and Johnson were able to place the offender in custody without any issues. The Victim was transported to the scene where the subject was apprehended for a show-up and was able to identify the offender as the person who had been inside the house. Further investigation revealed the Offender didn't live in the vicinity.

It is due to Officers Wright and Johnson's determination that led to the capture of this offender. It is this collective effort and constant display of professionalism that makes these Officers well deserving of the distinguished Officer of the Month Award.

Narrative:

On 06-26-17 at 1853 hours, uniform patrol officers Wright, Johnson and Delgado received a radio call, 9345 Balada St, burglary in progress, unknown black male inside the house.

Officers arrived at the house and met the house keeper who stated that she was inside the house when she observed a strange black male walk out of the home theater room. She asked him what he was doing, and he ran outside using a glass sliding door to the pool patio. He then fled south through the back yard, where she last saw him. She described him as a black male, 25 years old, dark tee shirt, green long shorts. She assumed he had gained entry through an unlocked sliding glass door. Officers could not find signs of forced entry.

Officers began to search the yards of the houses south of 9345, when officers Wright and Johnson located a black male hiding in the bushes on the south side of 9375 Balada St, three houses south of 9345. Officers placed offender in custody. Witness responded for a show-up and identified offender as the person who had been inside the house. Offender was arrested for occupied burglary and advised of his Miranda rights by officer Wright.

Defendant stated that he lived on 57 Av, and fled from his residence when he discovered a burglar was inside. (He could not provide his exact address or cross street on 57 Av). He then said he lived inside the sub division and knew all the residents, but could not provide any names of residents or an exact address number for his residence. Address on file revealed offender lived nowhere in the vicinity.

Defendant was transported to CGPD for further questioning by detective A. Fernandez, then transported to TGK.

Crime scene processed by Garcia-Velez, id 10871. Sgt E Lopez on scene.
