- c. HB 7069/State Education Funding Update
  - Iraida gives synopsis on per student budget allocations and HB 7069 which enacted many of the District's legislative priorities.
    - The big problem with 7069 is a mandate that school districts share revenue for facilities with charter schools, using public tax dollars to maintain private charter school buildings that will never belong to the public
    - Miami Dade County says charter school funding should come from different source.
    - There may be issues with meeting bond obligations for certain schools as a result of having to share funding with charters.
    - o Board is currently looking at \$52 million deficit in budget.
    - o MDCPS Board looking at possibly suing Florida legislature
      - Transfer of Capital outlay unconstitutional.

#### V. NEW BUSINESS

- a. 200 Club Presentation
  - Chiefs presentation on 200 Club (MDC Police + Fire)
    - The purpose is to financially assist families of officers killed in the line of duty and injured, etc.
