RESOLUTION NO. 2017-41

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF A GRANT FROM THE 2017 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM, TO PURCHASE MOTORCYCLE SADDLEBAG EMERGENCY LIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR UTILIZATION BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 ANNUAL BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE THE \$6,129 GRANT FUNDS AS REVENUE AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO COVER THE GRANT EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, The Coral Gables Police Department is the established local law enforcement agency for the provision of law enforcement services within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, The Coral Gables Police Department has identified the need to purchase motorcycle saddlebag emergency lighting equipment for utilization by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, The State of Florida Department of Law Enforcement awarded the Coral Gables Police Department a 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG-C) in the amount of \$6,129 to purchase motorcycle saddlebag emergency lighting equipment to be used by the Police Department's Traffic Enforcement Unit; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$6,129 grant funds as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the cost of the grant expenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the acceptance and execution of the 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG-C) to fund the purchase of motorcycle saddlebag emergency lighting equipment to be used by the Police Department's Traffic Enforcement Unit.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission hereby authorizes an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Annual Budget to recognize the \$6,129 grant funds as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the cost of the grant expenditures.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
