RESOLUTION NO. 2017-239

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION DIRECTING STAFF TO ADVERTISE A REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST (RFLI) REGARDING THE LAUNCH OF A TWELVE (12) MONTH PILOT FOR STATIONLESS BIKE-SHARE SERVICE IN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES.

WHEREAS, On June 10, 2014, the City Commission adopted the City of Coral Gables Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the plan recommends implementation of a bicycle-share system, following the development of the bicycle network as well as education and encouragement efforts; and

WHEREAS, bicycle-sharing systems provide an easy-to-use and inexpensive form of transportation; and

WHEREAS, offering this service to residents and visitors is well aligned with the strategic plan objectives to “improve mobility throughout the City,” “create accessible home-town recreation opportunities in all areas of the City” and “increase alternative mobility options by 2019.”; and

WHEREAS, a demonstration pilot provides residents and visitors with the opportunity to experience and evaluate bike-share as a mobility solution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon the adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission does hereby direct staff to advertise a Request for Letters of Interest (RFLI) regarding the launch of a twelve (12) month pilot for stationless bike-share service in the City of Coral Gables.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the date of its passage and adoption herein
