

## **ITEM TITLE:**

**Ordinance on First Reading. Zoning Code Text Amendment.** An Ordinance of the City Commission of Coral Gables, Florida providing for text amendments to the City of Coral Gables Official Zoning Code, by amending Article 4, "Development Standards," Section 4-201, "Mixed Use District (MXD);" Article 5, "Development Standards," Section 5-604, "Coral Gables Mediterranean Style Design Standards," and "Parking, Loading, and Driveway Standards," Section 5-1409, "Amount of Required Parking" to increase the requirements for bicycle parking; providing for a repealer provision, providing for a severability clause, codification, and providing for an effective date.

#### PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD RECOMMENDATION:

The Planning and Zoning Board at their 11.08.17 meeting recommended approval (vote: 7-0).

### **BRIEF HISTORY:**

The proposed Zoning Code text amendment will require covered, long-term bicycle parking in new development.

The City currently has a successful bike rack program that offers free bicycle racks with installation for any business that submits the request. These bike racks, typically located on the edge of the sidewalk, meet the need for short-term bike parking, such as shopping, dining at local restaurants, or dropping off children at school. The proposed amendment provides requirements for long-term bicycle parking for commuting and recreation.

The proposed amendment implements several goals and objectives outlined in both the Comprehensive Plan and Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan. This text amendment updates the current bicycle storage requirements for Mixed-Use District and Mediterranean bonuses to provide bicycle parking spaces for residential, office, and retail uses. The proposed amendment also provides new standards for bicycle storage for all parcels 20,000 square feet or greater to require bicycle parking for office, retail, and residential uses.

Many cities and municipalities contain similar provisions for bicycle parking in their zoning codes. This research is provided in the Staff Report as Exhibit B.

At their 11.08.17 meeting, the Planning and Zoning Board recommended approval of the proposed Zoning Code text amendment (vote: 7-0). The proposed amendment is provided in the draft Ordinance in strikethrough/underline format attached as Exhibit A.
