as possible.

complaints about the sewers. You know, there -- the draining of the sewer, how quickly the

water -- and I think for flooding, does it have to remain on -- for 24 hours to be considered

flood?

Assistant City Manager Iglesias: No. We look at -- some of the areas are highly susceptible to

tides.

Assistant City Manager Iglesias: About 9 to 10 inches of storage of water. So, we're in pretty good shape, except for our low-lying areas that are really susceptible to...
