

## **ITEM TITLE:**

**Resolution.** Park Impact Fee Preference. A Resolution of the City of Coral Gables Florida, providing a preference to utilize park impact fees for park acquisition unless such fees are otherwise earmarked for other park system improvements, and providing for an effective date. (Sponsored by Commissioner Lago)

## **BRIEF HISTORY:**

On March 28, 2017, the City Commission adopted an ordinance updating its Impact Fee Ordinance (Ord. 2017-09) and a companion Impact Fee Resolution (Reso. 2017-67) updating its impact fee schedule.

On December 5, 2017, the City Commission adopted Reso. 2017-357 for a Memorandum of Understanding with Miami-Dade County to fund a portion of the Underline Project with Coral Gables parks and mobility impact fees from new development within 1,000 feet of the Underline not to exceed \$15M.

This Resolution sets forth the policy preference of using future park impact fees for the purchase of park land, unless otherwise earmarked such as the Underline.

On March 20, 2018, the City Commission considered this Resolution, chose to not to take action, requested more information from the Parks Department and directed that the Resolution be placed on this agenda together with a presentation from the Parks Director.
