### PRESENTATIONS/DISCUSSIONS:

- Chairman Chamizo announced that he will presenting a Board's report to the City Commission meeting on April 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Discussion about public safety concerns such as channel markers, motion detectors, and lights along waterways took place. Solar fixtures for light under bridges was discussed. Light's color is a concern from a manatee migration point of view as well as marine patrol and navigation regulations. Board discussed replacement of all signage damaged due to hurricane Irma and also about CCTV at Cartagena Circle project.
- Discussion on parks and open spaces around Cartagena Circle/Cocoplum bridge, Blue Road, and Girl Scout took place. Mr. Swain presented an idea for Cartagena Circle park deck. Mr. Chamizo requested more information for any additional concerns.
- Water quality was explained and also DERM monitoring program. It was discussed the process to get funds to proceed with Dr. Samimi's project; results have not been published yet. Mrs. Anderson explained about Dr. Sumimi's study at UM canals and commented about the idea to have natural treatment along the canal at the Biltmore golf course area.
