## 1. APPLICATION REQUEST

The City of Coral Gables is requesting review and consideration of the following:

*An Ordinance of the City Commission of Coral Gables, Florida providing for a text amendment to the City of Coral Gables Official Zoning Code by amending Article 5, "Development Standards," Division 14, "Parking, Loading, and Driveway Requirements," Section 5-1405, "Landscaping, screening, and design" clarifying requirements for screening of integrated structured parking and requiring additional screening on parking garages; providing for severability, repealer, codification, and an effective date.*

## 2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

As directed by the Planning & Zoning Board, Staff has prepared Zoning Code text amendments to establish provisions to require garage openings to be screened from surrounding properties and rights-of-way to prohibit visibility of interior lights and car headlights.

## 3. PROPOSED ZONING CODE TEXT AMENDMENT

The proposed Zoning Code text amendment is provided below in ~~striketrough~~/underline format.

### ARTICLE 5 – Development Standards

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### Division 14. Parking, Loading, and Driveway Requirements

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### Section 5-1405. Landscaping, screening, and design.

A. General. Landscaping shall be provided as required by Article 5, Division 11.

B. Screening of integrated structured parking.

~~C. When required. Screening of parking that is structurally and architecturally integrated into or located under a building is required pursuant to this Section 5-1405(B)(2) when:~~

1. The building is in an MF2, MFSA, CL, C, I or MXD Districts;
2. Any part of the area in or under the building that is used for parking (from finished floor to ceiling) is located above established grade and closer than twenty (20) feet to the front building setback line; and
3. No intervening use (e.g., retail, lobby, etc.) is located between the parking and the front setback line ~~at ground level.~~

~~D. Parking garage exterior ~~façade treatment~~ design.~~

1. The exterior façades of parking garages ~~that are not subject to Subsection B~~ shall be designed and improved so that the use of the building for parking is not readily apparent-
- ~~2. Parking garages that are not subject to Subsection B and~~ shall reflect the architectural character and exterior finishes of the principal building that is to be served.
2. Parking garage openings shall be screened from surrounding properties and rights-of-way to minimize visible lights and car headlights.

E. Automated parking systems. Automated parking systems shall be located within a structure so that a visual barrier is in place to screen the parking from pedestrian view. The structure shall be subject to all standards that apply to the design and location of parking garages.

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#### 4. FINDINGS OF FACT

In accordance with Section 3-1405 of the Zoning Code, the Planning and Zoning Board shall not recommend adoption of, and the City Commission shall not adopt, text amendments to these land Zoning Code unless the text amendment:

- A. Promotes the public health, safety, and welfare.
- B. Does not permit uses the Comprehensive Plan prohibits in the area affected by the district boundary change or text amendment.
- C. Does not allow densities or intensities in excess of the densities and intensities which are permitted by the future land use categories of the affected property.
- D. Will not cause a decline in the level of service for public infrastructure which is the subject of a concurrency requirement to a level of service which is less the minimum requirements of the Comprehensive Plan.

E. Does not directly conflict with an objective or policy of the Comprehensive Plan.

Staff finds that all five of these criteria are satisfied.

## 5. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN CONSISTENCY

In accordance with Section 3-1407 of the Zoning Code, the Planning and Zoning Board shall determine whether the Zoning Code text amendment is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan. Staff finds that the proposed text amendment is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan.




