ROYAL POINCIANA FIESTA: Ms. Parnes updated the board. She was unable to arrange a meeting between the Flowering Tree Society and the City Manager to request sponsorship by the City of Coral Gables. UPDATE ON MISCELLANEOUS CITY PROJECTS:

MIRACLE MILE STREETSCAPE: The native orchids provided by Fairchild Tropical Gardens have been placed on the trees. The non-native orchids are being planted. The Silk Floss trees are being replaced.

HISTORIC ENTRANCES: The landscape improvements are in progress.

MERRICK HOUSE: Ms. Norman inquired on the list of the plantings from the 1976 original landscape design of the Merrick House that she gave to Ms. Bell-Llewellyn. Mr. Dannemiller advised the Garden Club is handling the plantings of Althea's Flower Garden.

LOUISE LAMAR CURRY PARK: Mr. Dannemiller advised the naming of the park will be presented before the Commission in October 2018.

POST IRMA TREE REPLACEMENT: The tree plantings will begin next week.

FIVE PASSIVE PARKS: Mr. Dannemiller advised the construction drawings are complete. The permitting and bidding will follow.

COMPREHENSIVE PARKS MASTER PLANS: Public meetings will be held soon.

DISCUSSION: Ms. Perez presented a letter from Pure Beauty Farms in which they offer the City of Coral Gables up to \$50,000 in plants annually. The letter was forwarded to the City Manager. Mr. Dannemiller advised the next step is to follow-up with Procurement. The decorative umbrellas on Giralda Avenue will be removed soon.
