RESOLUTION NO. 2019-54

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION EXTENDING THE AGREEMENTS BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES AND SKINNY LABS, INC (SPIN) AND BIRD RIDES, INC (BIRD) FOR NON-EXCLUSIVE SHARED MOBILITY DEVICE PILOT PROGRAMS IN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission previously entered into Memorandum of Understanding for non-exclusive pilot agreements with Spin and Bird; and

WHEREAS, the initial pilots were entered into in order to collect data and information to inform whether to enter into a formal solicitation process; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has chosen to move forward with a formal solicitation process for a shared mobility device program following the conclusion of the 2019 State Legislative session ; and

WHEREAS, while the City goes through the formal solicitation process for a shared mobility device program the City wants to continue to allow Spin and Bird to operate non-exclusive pilot programs so as to continue to provide last mile transportation options for residents and visitors to Coral Gables during the City's solicitation process; and

WHEREAS, City staff will continue determine the total number of scooters to be deployed and continue to work with both Operators to determine appropriate deployment locations; and

WHEREAS, the non-exclusive personal mobility shared program pilots with Spin and Bird will continue through the City's execution of an agreement(s) for a shared mobility device program following a formal solicitation process and may be terminated at any time upon fifteen (15) days written notice from the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon the adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission does hereby authorize the City Manager to execute amendments extending the non-exclusive pilot programs for shared mobility devices with Spin and Bird through the City's execution of an agreement(s) for a shared mobility device program following a formal solicitation process. The City shall retain the ability to terminate the extended pilot(s) at any time upon fifteen (15) days written notice from the City.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


