WHEREAS, travel is a pillar of economic growth, creating jobs at a faster rate than any other sector, thus more than 142,100 people were employed by the travel and tourism industry this past year, amassing 16.5 million overnight visitors to Greater Miami and the Beaches, contributing to local businesses and jobs, spending an estimated \$17 billion dollars into our local economy on lodging, food, shopping, transportation and entertainment, resulting in 34 percent of our state sales taxes being collected; and

WHEREAS, in our own City, whether one is addressing the top-rated hotels, restaurants, or attractions, Coral Gables has increasingly become a destination of choice for many travelers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RAUL VALDES-FAULI, as Mayor of the City of Coral Gables, along with the members of our City Commission, do hereby proclaim May 2019 as:
