RESOLUTION NO. 2019-109

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A ONE-YEAR WARRANTY AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH HARRINGTON RESOURCES INC. DBA PARKER SYSTEMS TO PROVIDE MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE FOR T2 LUKE II PAY-STATIONS CITYWIDE

WHEREAS, the City purchased and installed an additional Thirty-Five new T2 Luke II pay-stations in 2015 from T2 Systems Canada Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City currently has Thirty-Eight T2 Luke II pay-stations installed on-street within the City; and

WHEREAS, the agreement entered on August 3, 2015 with T2 Systems Canada Inc. included a two-year warranty as well as an additional three-year extended warranty at a fixed rate; and

WHEREAS, the initial warranty and maintenance agreement is now expired, and Parker Systems is the exclusive source of parts and service within the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables is interested in continuing the warranty agreement with Parker Systems for an additional one-year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a one-year extension of the maintenance and service agreement with Parker Systems covering all T2 Luke pay-stations.


SECTION 2. That the one-year extension will be in the total amount of Thirty-Six Thousand One-Hundred Dollars (\$36,100).
