Raimundo Rodulfo, Director of Information and Technology in addressing the City Commission stated that the City partnered with the University of Miami to design and launch "Design your Coral Gables" by inviting participants to bring their ideas for designing and prototyping traffic and transportation solutions and integrating them into Coral Gables Smart City technology hub public platform, in which great ideas were birth from this partnership. The participants present received awards, and those not present will also be given awards in addition to certificates for their collaborative efforts. Teams were awarded first, second, and third prizes for their respective projects. A video was then shown of the participants interacting and brainstorming with each other to find solutions.

Vice Mayor Lago indicated that he was appointed as Vice Chairman to the Urban Mobility Task Force by Mayor Oliver Gilbert, Chairman of the Miami-Dade County Transportation Planning Organization. He and other officials from various cities will be working together to devise alternative modes of transportation and the City of Coral Gables will have one individual to put on that task force; and that this falls right in line with what the Smart City Solution teams are doing. The task force is going to be tasked with coming up with ideas over the next six months and he encouraged community involvement regarding urban cities like the City of Coral Gables. They will have a \$150,000 budget to come-up with a comprehensive study and to bring exceptional ideas to address transportation issues and concerns for the next 30 to 40 years. Mayor Valdes-Fauli thanked everyone and being able to work with the County in solving our transportation issues. He further stated that our City is in the middle of the County and the importance of working together with them. He again thanked and congratulated the teams which participated.

The Flagler Neighborhood Association, which is that area north of 8th Street, between north and...8th Street that goes up to Flagler, and we were looking at them for well over a year, two years now on some different projects and Ramon was there, and it was a very good meeting in helping them to identify priorities. There was something that came out

though in the meeting. Apparently, there is a homeless woman that spends a great deal of time in that area and she uses the public rights-of-way usually to go to the bathroom and leaves her waste and different things, and we haven't been particularly effective in helping to move her to a place where she could have some treatment. Now, I know that we purchased beds at one time, and we had that with Camillus House. Camillus House is a facility primarily for men.

Mayor Valdes-Fauli: Where is it?

Commissioner Keon:...in addition to - most of the treatment centers are - I would like us maybe, in addition to Camillus House, if we could look at shelters or programs that also assist women, I know Lotus House is one of them, but I don't know that that is appropriate for them, but if we could find maybe an additional resource that is also specific for women, we would look into it. Now, I don't know who would do that. I'll ask the Manager to look into that. If you could just look into it and come back and see what would be involved in that, because I am noticing more and more homeless women. Just let us know what the responsibility or feasibility of doing that is. The issue with traffic enforcement - people in FedEx trucks and everything else continue to park on the swale, and I see the police sitting there oftentimes in their SUV's doing their notes or whatever, instead of moving them. Would you please talk to the Police Department about the enforcement? Apparently, someone said something to one of the FedEx trucks and they told them that they weren't aware of it, or the police officer that they were supposed to move them, and they said, oh, they weren't aware of it. If you could just give them - have a conversation. That's all. Thank you.

Vice Mayor Lago: I forgot to mention one thing quickly. The signage, and I've mentioned it before, in front of Doctor's Hospital and Coral Gables High, it's a little bit deteriorated. I wanted to see if we could have staff make that a point. I know Commissioner Mena has mentioned that before. So, let's look at just Doctor's Hospital and signage for also Coral Gables High. I'm not talking about going out and cite them, just let's work with them. Figure out what's going on. Maybe they are in a timeframe where they are redesigning, or they already ordered the sign.

Public Works Director Diaz: Just really quick. We do have a project to improve certain signage, I believe that's one of them.

Vice Mayor Lago: Both - Coral Gables High and Doctor's Hospital?

Public Works Director Diaz: Doctor's Hospital, Coral Gables High, I believe so, but I'm not sure, definitely Doctor's Hospital.

Vice Mayor Lago: You have a timeframe for delivery?

Public Works Director Diaz: Not yet. Some of them are on a State road, so we are trying to figure out how we are going to go around that one, because they may say you can't have it there anymore.

Vice Mayor Lago: Thank you.

Mayor Valdes-Fauli: I have one last item, very, very last; and it's an invitation today at 5:30 at the Biltmore, and that a resident of Salamanca is going to announce that they are going to open a facility here, an extended educational facility here. It is one of the oldest universities in Europe and we should be very proud that they have chosen us, and you are all invited, the Biltmore, 5:30.

Commissioner Keon: Where at in the Biltmore?

Mayor Valdes-Fauli: Thank you very much.
