**BRIEF HISTORY:**

Historically, the City of Coral Gables has held its City Commission meetings on Tuesdays, once or twice each month, with the meetings being called to order at approximately nine o'clock (9:00) A.M..

Many members of the public who may wish to speak on certain agenda items, particularly on items of great public importance, may be unable to attend the City Commission meetings being held during regular working hours.

In those months where the City Commission has two regularly scheduled meetings, the Commission finds that it would facilitate public participation for one of the two meetings that month to begin no earlier than five o'clock (5:00) P.M. In addition, when an agenda item is of great public importance, as determined by resolution of this Commission, such agenda item shall be heard at least once before final action of this Commission at a time later than five o'clock (5:00) P.M.
