At the October 8, 2019 City Commission Meeting an award recommendation for RFP 2019-020 Group Dental Insurance will be included on the agenda. This memorandum (and attached supplemental information) serves to notify you that in accordance with Section 2-763 of the City Code entitled "Contract Award", my recommendation to the City Commission for award of the subject RFP is as follows:

- Accept the recommendation of the Procurement Officer, and in conjunction with the Evaluation/Selection Committee to award the RFP and authorize negotiations with Humana Insurance Company and CompBenefits Company the highest ranked responsive and responsible proposer, for Group Dental Insurance, RFP 2019-020.
- 2) Should negotiations fail with the top-ranked proposer, authorize the Human Resources Director, after consultation with the Procurement Officer, to negotiate with the next most qualified proposer, up to the fourth ranked qualified Proposer, until a satisfactory agreement and contract amount that is fair, competitive, and reasonable is reached.

On June 11, 2019, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued, and distributed Group Dental Insurance, Request for Proposals (RFP) 2019-020. Twenty-three (23) prospective proposers downloaded the RFP package from Public Purchase, the City's web-based e-Procurement service.

On July 19, 2019, six (6) firms submitted proposals in response to the RFP: Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company (CHLIC); Florida Combined Life Insurance Company; Humana Insurance Company and CompBenefits Company; Metropolitan Life Insurance Company (Metlife); Solstice Benefits, Inc.; and Standard Insurance Company (The Standard).

On August 21, 2019, the Evaluation Committee convened to evaluate the six (6) responsive proposals and ranked the firms in the following order of preference: Humana Insurance Company and CompBenefits Company (top-ranked); Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company (CHLIC) (second ranked); Metropolitan Life Insurance Company (Metlife) (third ranked); Solstice Benefits, Inc. (fourth ranked); Standard Insurance Company (The Standard) (fifth ranked); and Florida Combined Life Insurance Company (sixth ranked). The Evaluation Committee determined that Humana Insurance Company and CompBenefits Company was the highest ranked responsive-responsible proposer. The Evaluation Committee further recommended that should negotiations fail with Humana Insurance Company and CompBenefits Company, that negotiations commence with the next ranked firm, up to the fourth ranked firm, until an agreement and contract amount acceptable to the City has been reached.

After successful negotiations, a Professional Services Agreement will be executed. A more detailed description of the RFP, proposal response and evaluation results will be provided to you as part of the Agenda package.
