A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, RELATING TO SECURITY SERVICES ASSESSMENTS WITHIN THE BANYAN DRIVE **TAXING** SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL CONFIRMING THE INITIAL ASSESSMENT RESOLUTION: IMPOSING SECURITY **SERVICES** ASSESSMENTS: APPROVING THE SECURITY SERVICES ASSESSMENT PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Coral Gables (the "Commission"), Florida, enacted the Assessment Ordinance to permit the imposition of assessments to fund enhanced security services, facilities, and programs for the benefit of the property owners within the Banyan Drive Security Guard Special Taxing District (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2019, the Commission adopted Resolution No. 2019-195 (the "Initial Assessment Resolution"), initiating the process to collect Assessments within the District pursuant to the Uniform Assessment Collection Act set forth in section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, and directing preparation of the preliminary Security Services Assessment Roll and provision of the notices required by the Assessment Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Assessment Ordinance, the Commission is required to confirm or repeal the Initial Assessment Resolution, with such amendments as the Commission deems appropriate, after hearing comments and receiving objections of all interested parties; and

WHEREAS, the Security Services Assessment Roll has heretofore been filed with the office of the City Clerk, as required by the Assessment Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, as required by the terms of the Assessment Ordinance, notice of a public hearing has been published and mailed to each property owner proposed to be assessed notifying such property owner of the opportunity to be heard; the proof of publication and an affidavit of mailing are attached hereto as Appendices A and B respectively; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 12, 2019, and comments and objections of all interested persons have been heard and considered as required by the terms of the Assessment Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY. This Resolution is adopted pursuant to the Assessment Ordinance, the Initial Assessment Resolution, Article VIII, Section 2, Florida Constitution, the City of Coral Gables Charter, Section 166.021, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of law.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

- (A) This Resolution is the Final Assessment Resolution as defined in the Assessment Ordinance
- (B) All capitalized terms in this Resolution shall have the meanings defined in the Assessment Ordinance and the Initial Assessment Resolution.

SECTION 3. CONFIRMATION OF INITIAL ASSESSMENT RESOLUTION. The Initial Assessment Resolution is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. APPROVAL OF SECURITY SERVICES ASSESSMENT ROLL.

- (A) The Security Services Assessment Roll, a copy of which is attached hereto as Appendix C, is hereby approved for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019.
- (B) Additionally, the Security Services Assessment Roll, as approved, includes those Tax Parcels/Folios within the District that cannot be set forth in that Security Services Assessment Roll due to the provisions of Chapter 2019-12, Laws of Florida, concerning exempt "home addresses" under Section 119.071(d), Florida Statutes.

SECTION 5. IMPOSITION OF ASSESSMENTS.

- (A) The Tax Parcels/Folios described in the Security Services Assessment Roll are hereby found to be specially benefited by the provision of the Security Services funded by the Security Service Cost in the amount of the maximum annual Assessment set forth in the Security Services Assessment Roll.
- (B) For the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019, the Security Service Cost for the District is \$371,492.03. For the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019, the Assessment is \$7,581.47 for each improved Lot/Unit and \$3,790.74 for each Vacant Lot/Unit.
- (C) The methodology for computing annual Assessments in the Initial Assessment Resolution is hereby approved and found to be a fair and reasonable method of apportioning the Security Service Cost among the benefited properties.
- (D) Annual Assessments computed in the manner described in the Initial Assessment Resolution are hereby levied and imposed on all Tax Parcels/Folios within the District for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019.

(E) Upon adoption of this Resolution, the Assessments shall constitute a lien against Assessed Property equal in rank and dignity with the liens of all state, county, district or municipal taxes and other non-ad valorem assessments. Except as otherwise provided by law, such lien shall be superior in dignity to all other liens, titles and claims, until the ad valorem tax bill for such year is otherwise paid in full pursuant to the Uniform Assessment Collection Act. The lien shall be deemed perfected upon adoption by the Commission of this Resolution and shall attach to the property included on the Security Services Assessment Roll as of the prior January 1, the lien date for ad valorem taxes.

SECTION 6. COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS.

- (A) The Assessments shall be collected pursuant to the Uniform Assessment Collection Act as authorized in the Assessment Ordinance. The Security Services Assessment Roll, as herein approved, shall be delivered to the Tax Collector for collection using the tax bill collection method in the manner prescribed by the Assessment Ordinance.
- (B) The Security Services Assessment Roll, as delivered to the Tax Collector, shall be accompanied by a Certificate to Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll in substantially the form attached hereto as Appendix D. The Property Appraiser and Tax Collector shall apply the Assessment rates approved herein to any Tax Parcels/Folios in the Distrct with exempt "home addresses" pursuant to Section 119.071(d), Florida Statutes.

SECTION 7. EFFECT OF RESOLUTION. The adoption of this Resolution shall be the final adjudication of the issues presented herein and in the Initial Assessment Resolution (including, but not limited to, the method by which the Assessments will be

computed, the Security Services Assessment Roll, the maximum annual Assessment, the levy and lien of the Assessments and the terms for prepayment of the Assessments) unless proper steps are initiated in a court of competent jurisdiction to secure relief within 20 days from the date of Commission action on this Resolution.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.



NOTICE OF HEARING TO IMPOSE AND PROVIDE FOR COLLECTION OF SECURITY SERVICES SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

Notice is hereby given that the City Commission of the City of Coral Gables, Florida, will conduct a public hearing to consider the imposition of special assessments for the provision of enhanced neighborhood security services, facilities, and programs for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019 and future fiscal years within the boundaries of the Banyan Drive Security Guard Special Taxing District ("District"), which includes all lands shown on the map set forth above. In the past, the District was established by Metropolitan Dade County, but was recently transferred to the City of Coral Gables. The enlianced neighborhood security services, facilities, and programs will initially include administration and the design, permitting, construction, and installation of the neighborhood guardhouse, security gates at the neighborhood antrance, security cameras, recording equipment, and associated improvements. Thereafter, upon the completion of these capital improvements the enhanced neighborhood security services, facilities, and programs will include administration, maintenance, and the provision of visible safety and sentinel security using unarmed uniformed guards operating from the guardhouse and video recording of all vehicles entering and exiting the District to be provided 24 hours per day, 365 days per year.

The hearing will be held at 3:00 p.m. on September 12, 2019, in Commission Chambers, City Hall, 405 Bittmore Way, Florida, for the purpose of receiving public comment on the imposition and collection of the assessments on the ad valorent tax bill. All affected property owners have a right to appear at the hearing and to file written objections with the City within 20 days of this notice. If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Commission with respect to any match consistent at the hearing, such-person will seed a record of the proceedings and may need to ensure that a verbatim record is made, including the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be made.

Any person who needs assistance in another language in order to speak during the public hearing or public comment portion of the meeting should contact the City's ADA Coordinator Raquel Elejabarrieta, Esq., Director of Labor, Relations and Risk Management (E-mail: relejabarrieta@coralgables.or, Telephone: 305-722-6866, TTYT/DD: 305-442-1600), at least three (3) business days before the meeting:

Any person with a disability requiring communication assistance (such as a sign language interpreter or other auxiliary aide or service) in order to attend or participate in the meeting, should contact the City's ADA Coordinator Raquef Elejabarrieta, Esq., Director of Labor Relations and Risk Management (E-mail: relejabarrieta@coralgables.com, Telephone: 305-722-8686, TTV/TDD: 305-442-1690), at least three (3) business days before the meeting.

The Assessment for each parcel of property will be based upon the total number of lots/units attributed to that parcel. Vacant lots/unit will be assigned one-half of a lot/unit for each vacant lot/unit. The annual assessment will include each Tay Parcel/Folio's share of the service cost, plus administrative and collection costs. The maximum annual assessment is estimated to be \$7,581.47 per (improved lot/unit and \$3,790.74 per vacant lot/unit. A more specific description is set forth in the Initial Assessment Resolution adopted by the City Commission on June 11, 2019. Copies of the Master Service Assessment Ordinance, the Initial Assessment Resolution; and the preliminary Assessment Roll are available for inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, 405 Biltmore Way, Coral Gables, Florida

The assessments will be collected on the ad valorem tax bill to be mailed in November 2019, as authorized by Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes. Failure to pay the assessments will cause a tax certificate to be issued against the real property which may result in a loss of title.

3. On or before August 22, 2019, Ms. Gomez caused the mailing of the above-referenced notices in accordance with the Assessment Ordinance and the Initial Assessment Resolution by First Class Mail to each affected owner, at the addresses then shown on the real property assessment tax roll database maintained by the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser for the purpose of the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes.


