## CITY OF CORAL GABLES Donald R. Hopkins and William A. Cooper Scholarship Committee June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 10:11 am. A quorum was present.

**Committee voted** for the graduate program (pilot program) to allow 1 student per year until more money presents itself, and for there to be a focus on high school students. Moved, Leona Cooper Baker Seconded, Edwina Prime

**Committee voted** scholarships will be revoked if minimum requirements are not met unless there is an extenuating circumstance, and if such there must be written documentation and proof that must be submitted to prove such circumstances. Moved, Edwina Prime Seconded, Leona Cooper Baker Yes, Linda Dixie

**Committee voted** that meeting scholarship deadlines are important, and if students don't adhere to them, the award will be revoked if deadline is not met. Moved, Leona Cooper Baker Seconded, Edwina Prime Yes, Linda Dixie

The Committee members discussed whether or not the scholarship should be extended to graduate students. The Committee **voted** to launch a pilot program for a book allowance for graduate students. Presently the Committee did not vote to extend the scholarship to graduate students as they do with undergraduates because the focus should be on high school students and until there are more funds available they do not presently feel it should be extended. There was a concern with the available funding and a discussion regarding making the overall scholarship standards stricter. Moved, Linda Dixie Seconded, Edwina Prime Yes, Leona Cooper Baker

The Committee members discussed a scholarship reception for students and past cooper baker scholarship recipients to be held at their Community Center (Community Foundation Scholarship Reception, Mary Snow).

**The Committee voted** on a graduate book scholarship stipend of \$500. There was mentioned of Willie Gibson who may be reaching out to be the first student to receive this. The pilot program will be re-evaluated each year per student requesting. Motioned, Linda Dixie Second, Edwina Prime Yes, Leona Baker

**The Committee voted** to award Kayla Martinez \$1,500 for the Donald Hopkins William Cooper Scholarship for 2019. Motioned, Linda Dixie Second, Leona Baker Yes, Edwina Prime
