## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-360**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AUTHORIZE A "PIGGYBACK" CONTRACT FROM MIAMIDADE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT WITH INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 FOR EACH CONTRACT YEAR TO INCLUDE RENEWALS, NOT TO EXCEED THE AVAILABLE BUDGETED FUNDS, FOR REHABILITATION OF SANITARY SEWER BY THE CURED-IN-PLACE PIPE LINING METHOD, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-945, OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED, "USE OF OTHER GOVERNMENTAL UNIT CONTRACTS (PIGGYBACK)".

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2019, Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department executed an agreement with Insituform Technologies, LLC, for a Two-Year Countywide Contract for Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers by the Cured-In-Place Pipe Lining Method; and

WHEREAS, the agreement is effective for a period of two (2) years and may be renewed for two (2) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has requested the use of the Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC for Citywide repairs to the City's sanitary sewer conveyance systems to reduce and/or eliminate groundwater infiltration and storm water inflow; and

WHEREAS, repairs to the City's sanitary sewer system to reduce inflow and infiltration are required on an on-going basis to ensure compliance with Miami-Dade County Code, Section 24-42.2; and

WHEREAS, the determination has been made that Insituform Technologies, LLC, will best meet the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City follows Miami-Dade County Standards for sanitary sewer systems and piggybacking a Miami-Dade County contract and approved contractor will allow the City to continue to meet those standards; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Officer pursuant to Section 2-945 "Use of Other Governmental Unit Contracts (Piggyback)," of the Procurement Code, recommends authorizing a "piggyback" contract from Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department with Insituform Technologies, LLC, as the contract is active and was competitively solicited;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE **CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof

SECTION 2. That the City Commission accepts the recommendation of the Procurement Officer to authorize a "Piggyback" contract from Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department with Insituform Technologies, LLC, in an estimated amount of \$1,000,000 for each contract year to include renewals, not to exceed the available budgeted funds, for Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewer by the Cured-In-Place Pipe Lining Method, pursuant to Section 2-945, of the Procurement Code entitled, "Use of Other Governmental Unit Contracts (Piggyback).

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
