Andreu World America cannot be held responsible for receipt of defective fabrics, as we apply all COM's as first quality goods.

Andreu World America requires a cutting of the COM fabric to be attached to the purchase order to reduce the likelihood of errors in upholstering.

COM/COL should be shipped freight prepaid to our facilities, It should be clearly tagged with our order number, item number, description and quantity, to permit proper identification. Andreu World America is not responsible for any delays caused by untagged or late COM.

1- WOOD/LACQUER

The majority of the beech, oak walnut, maple, and ash woods used in the AW collections is obtained from sustainable wood sources. The FSC® (Forest Stewardship Council) certificate guarantees that our FSC®-certified products have been extracted from reforested areas and are prepared according to the FSC® Principles and Criteria, which define the minimum standards for good forest management worldwide.

MAINTENANCE

We recommend cleaning stains with a damp cloth and a soap solution.

2- WEBBING

1.25 inch thick polypropylene webbing with satin finish. Used in Valeria and Smart collection,

MAINTENANCE

To clean, gently wipe the webbing belts using a brush and a cloth soaked in soapy water. Remove the excess soap and dry with a cloth.

The Andreu World catalog offers different types of fabrics, leathers and synthetic leathers manufactured by world-leading companies.

MAINTENANCE

Information on maintenance, composition and technical characteristics, as well as the suitability of each fabric for use as covers, can be found in our upholstery catalogs.

4- CERAMICS

The ceramic tops and boards of the bases and tables included in the Andreu World are waterproof, hygienic and colorfast. They are fireproof and abrasion-resistant, as well as 100% recyclable.

MAINTENANCE

We recommend the use of regular detergents for cleaning. Lime, wine, ice cream, coffee and grease stains should be removed using an alkaline detergent or a descaling product. Wipe clean bird droppings as quickly as possible, since they can cause permanent stains,

5.- HIGH PRESSURE LAMINATES

The high pressure laminate table tops are suitable for outdoor use. They are treated against UV action and are highly resistant to wear, heat and moisture.

MAINTENANCE

The surface should be cleaned with a nonabrasive sponge, water and detergent. The imporosity of the surface helps prevent the penetration of dirt. Wipe clean bird droppings as soon as possible, since they can cause permanent stains on the surface of high pressure laminate.

6. - LAMINATED BOARDS

The laminated plywood table tops are suitable for covered outdoor spaces. They are extremely resistant to impacts and scratches and have been specifically designed for those uses which require a high-quality finish and a consistent surface.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning is simple and only requires water and detergent.

7-STEEL

MAINTENANCE

Chromed steel requires regular cleaning with soapy water. In the case of stains, avoid abrasive sponges or fabrics.

Stainless steel only requires regular cleaning with soapy water. Stainless steel is synonymous with an attractive finish and durability. Any stains caused by aggressive products require a specific cleaning:

- Water- and lime-stains: Remains of lime can be removed by soaking with a 25% vinegar solution or a 15% nitric acid solution, Rinse well and continue washing with soap or detergent and water. Rinse with hot water. Wipe dry with a soft, clean cloth.
- Oil and Grease: Rinse with an organic/hydrocarbon (e.g., alcohol) product, then clean with soap or detergent and water. Rinse well with cold water and a dry cloth. Soaking is advisable before cleaning with hot soapy water.
- Tea and Coffee stains: Wash with washing soda (sodium bicarbonate) and hot water. Then wash with soap or detergent and water. Rinse thoroughly with hot water. Wipe dry with a soft, clean cloth.

For the correct maintenance of stainless steel structures in areas near the coast and for areas in permanent contact with marine environments, we recommend regular cleaning with soapy water.

8- THERMO-POLYMER
