Investigate complaints of abuse immediately, and thoroughly, and dismiss and prosecute officers who act illegally. Dismiss/prosecute bystander officers who abet illegal behavior. None of these things should be questionable, and they should be the backbone of our city.

If these actions are difficult or prohibited because of police unions, please make that known so the citizens can lobby the unions to do the right thing to make our community safe, just, and welcoming for every single citizen.
