

ITEM TITLE:

Resolution. A Resolution adopting the Capital Improvement Program for the five fiscal years from 2021 to 2025.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION:

Approval.

BRIEF HISTORY:

On an annual basis, the City Manager prepares and submits to the City Commission a Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for the upcoming fiscal year (2021) and the four subsequent fiscal years (2022-2025). The CIP is a comprehensive Plan that addresses short term and long term regulatory, structural, maintenance, quality of life and beautification needs.

The projects included in the 2021-2025 CIP have an estimated aggregate cost of \$334,121,728. This plan is made up of the following project categories and amounts:
