
Concept #4. Excluding City Hall and utilizing Salzedo as a closed off street for a dedicated Hub.








Concept #6. Utilizing the plaza a the corner of Miracle Mile and Lejeune to enter the alley way running parallel to Miracle Mile on the 5 views

Required, applicable, Safety Guidelines for Arts and Culture as outlined in 'The New Normal' document provided by Miami-Dade County.

- Install hand sanitizing stations at entrances and in common areas
- Space out customer queues venue entry and at ticketing booths with floor markers (every 6 ft); adopt virtual waiting area / queue where feasible
- Procure appropriate amounts of soap, hand sanitizer, cleaning materials and protection equipment (masks, gloves)
- Mark with arrows entry and exit points, creating one-way circulation paths inside venue when possible; otherwise, enforce distancing by posting signs indicating 6' separation
- Suspend group tours and group programming; implement circulation control measures to support social and physical distancing
- Eliminate the use of interactive exhibits unless a plan for application of protective measures has been approved
- Train all personnel in new operating protocols and modifications to existing codes of conduct to deal with Covid-19 issues
- Post CDC signage in publicly trafficked locations emphasizing measures to "Stop the Spread of Germs" (CDC) and exercise social responsibility (e.g., hygiene)
- Post a contact email address and/or telephone number for customers to contact if they have questions or concerns

Illuminate Coral Gables:

- ✓ All patrons will be asked to wear a face covering.
- ✓ Surgical masks will be available through volunteer exhibit attendants
- ✓ Hand sanitizing stations will be placed at all exhibit sites and Fireflies onboarding/offboarding sites
- ✓ Signage will display safety protocols at all exhibit locations
- ✓ Each Fireflies pedicab will be disinfected between rides
- ✓ Fireflies rides will be limited to family members
- \checkmark Social distancing markers will be placed on the ground around exhibits and were lines may form

- ✓ Safety Ambassadors trained to politely enforce all protocols


