# SUMMER FAMILY LITERACY FESTIVAL (SUMMER FAMILY BOOK FAIR) PILOT PROJECT FACT SHEET

### **EVENT DESCRIPTION:**

The Summer Family Literacy Festival (SFLF), similar to the Miami Book Fair International hosted annually at Miami Dade College, will treat fair goers to a daylong celebration of all things literary including activities for children, young adults and other family members of all ages and abilities. The purpose of the Summer Family Literacy Festival is to promote reading, encourage writing, and heighten an awareness of literacy and the literary arts in our city's multi-ethnic community.

Festival programming/activities will include author presentations, street fair with literacy exhibitors and vendors, free literacy screenings and evaluations, children's and young adult zones, book donation and exchange areas, Youth/Children's Alley with performance stage, storytellers, an International Village with representation from our city's sister city and consular communities, a main stage, food and drink vendors, a special visit from the Miami-Dade Public Library System's Techno Bus, and literary tours of libraries and literary establishments located throughout the "City Beautiful".
