A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION INSTRUCTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO MOVE FORWARD WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES IN A MULTIDISTRICT LITIGATION AGAINST PHARMACEUTICAL COMPANIES WITH REGARD TO OPIOID ABUSE.

WHEREAS, there is a nationwide public health crisis regarding opioid abuse and pharmaceutical companies have been irresponsible in their regulation of opioids; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has sent a memorandum to the City Commission explaining the different claims involved in the multidistrict litigation against the pharmaceutical companies, the amount of damages sought, and potential injunctive relief; and

WHEREAS, involvement by the City in the multidistrict litigation would be at no risk to the City because it would be handled on a contingency basis; and

WHEREAS, other municipalities have joined the multidistrict litigation against the pharmaceutical companies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

- **SECTION 1.** That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.
- **SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby authorize the City Attorney to move forward with other municipalities in a multidistrict litigation against pharmaceutical companies with regard to opioid abuse.
- **SECTION 3.** That said Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
