All interested parties are hereby notified that the Board of Adjustment of the City of Coral Gables, Florida, will hold a VIRTUAL MEETING for the purpose of hearing variance requests and taking action on such requests, reviewing and taking action on appeals from Administrative Officials, and other matters, as outlined in Section 14-104 of Ordinance No. 2021-07, as amended and known as the "Zoning Code" of the City of Coral Gables, Florida, to wit:

Case No. BA-21-05-7934 Requests: Variance for the property located at 7550 Old Cutler Road

- 11. Variance to allow a swimming pool and pool deck to be located in the area between the street and the main residential building vs. no accessory building or structures may be located in the area between the street and the main résidential building, as required by Sections 2-101.D(5) and 3-301.B of the Coral Gables Zoning Code.
- 2. Variance to allow a swimming pool and pool deck to be located closer to the side street of a lot or building site than the main or principal building vs. in no case shall a swimming pool be located closer to the front or side street of a lot or building site than the main or principal building, as required by Sections 2-101.D(5), 3-301.C, and 3-308.I of the Coral Gables Zoning Code.
- 3. Variance to allow a swimming pool and pool deck to be visible in both the front and side street elevation vs. on corner lots, swimming pools may be located within an L of the building provided that such L is not visible in both the front and side street elevation, as required by Section 3-308.H of the Coral Gables Zoning Code.
