

**RESOLUTION.** A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THAT REGULAR CITY COMMISSION MEETINGS BEGIN AT 9 A.M. AND DIRECTING THAT CERTAIN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA ITEMS BE HEARD NO EARLIER THAN 4:00 P.M.

## **BRIEF HISTORY:**

The City Commission has historically held its regularly set meetings at 9:00 A.M. The City Commission has found that certain items of great public interest should be heard later in the day to accommodate people who may find it difficult to attend meetings during the work day. As such, this draft resolution directs that regular meetings of the City Commission are to begin at 9:00 A.M., though from time to time the Mayor, as Chair of the Commission, may determine that certain presentation and protocol items, or individual appearances are to be heard prior to 9:00 A.M. In addition, the City Clerk and City Manager are directed to ensure that certain agenda items be heard no earlier that 4:00 P.M. at least once before final action of the Commission. Those items include:

- 1) Amendments to the City Comprehensive Plan or Land Use Map;
- 2) Mixed-Use projects requiring City Commission approval, Planned Area Development (PAD) applications, any project requiring Conditional Use Approval, and amendments to developments, site plans, or PADs previously approved by the City Commission that require Commission approval; and
- 3) Any other items as directed by a majority of the Commission.
