ITEM TITLE:

ORDINANCE ON FIRST READING: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES CODE BY CREATING CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION", ARTICLE III "BOARDS AND COMMITTEES", DIVISION 7 "LANDMARKS ADVISORY BOARD" PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER PROVISION, SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE (Sponsored by Commissioner Anderson)

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City of Coral Gables is home to various entrances, landmarks and historic features; and, presently the City has boards and committees in place which assist City staff in the oversight and maintenance of City infrastructure.

There may be a gap in City board and committee oversight as it relates to the City-owned and/or maintained entrances, plazas, fountains, historically significant poles and lights, historic markers, statues, and other historically significant landmarks or item. As such, the City Commission believes that the addition of a Landmarks Advisory Board would provide resident oversight of the extensive landmarks throughout the City and allow a structure for residents and board members to review the condition of entryways and landmarks and bring maintenance issues to the City's attention in a timely manner to avoid deterioration.

The board would consist of seven members, residents of the City, with a demonstrated passion for preservation of Coral Gables landmarks, and the City's public works department would serve as administrative support staff for the board.
