Staff member Garcia presented current ideas for the city's upcoming centennial anniversary, including:

- Lapel pins
- Local schools painting fire hydrants in high-traffic areas
  - Pantin to follow up with the City Attorney's office regarding allowed colors and any other regulations.
- Oral History project
  - Airaghi mentioned a potential interviewee candidate
    - Communications staff to follow up.
- Communications staff to reach out to Beaux Arts regarding involvement in the centennial per Airaghi's suggestion.
- Communications staff mentioned meeting with the principal and pastor of St. Theresa School and Church of the Little Flower the week prior.
- Garcia presented a demonstration of an augmented reality program created by IT staff for potential use at historic sites.

- Pantin mentioned possibly coordinating a city trolley tour per the City Manager's suggestion.
  - Pantin to meet with Parking staff on this.
  - Airaghi mentioned offering sponsorship opportunities.

Garcia presented a mockup of a centennial-themed manhole cover for placement in high-visibility areas.

  - Instagram followers approaching 75,000 followers.
    - Committee members suggested a contest to increase followers (similar to previous contests at varying X0,000 follower marks).
