Ms. Ramudo brought the meeting to order at 8:10 a.m.

Welcome and Introduction

Mr. Thad Adams was introduced by Mr. Perez as the new Board member appointed by the Chamber of Commerce.

1. COVID Status & Vaccine

Chief de la Rosa updated Board members that the guidelines for Community Vaccinations came out early December 2020. The City of Coral Gables through the Emergency Management Division applied

with the Department of Health to be a POD or a Point of Distribution for vaccines. A plan was put in place for the City and the State that was commensurate with the CDC guidelines and State on how we would be able to distribute the vaccinations.

2. Technology in the City Update

Mr. Rodolfo updated Board members on the technologies that have been implemented in working together with all the city departments over the last five to six years. We also have the diesel transformation part making our City more efficient and continuously improving our process with technology. In August, the City will launch a paperless system to become more efficient. The City of Coral Gables has been recognized as a Smart City with multiple awards. We have been named one of eight Smart City's to watch nationwide.

3. Retail Update

Ms. Valdes updated Board members with the latest restaurant and retail new openings in the Downtown area.

4. Business Tax License Report

Ms. Valdes updated Board members of the new and upcoming businesses in Coral Gables.

5. Open Discussion

Mr. Niebla inquired about the City of Miami's Mayor doing a big push on technology and attracting new talent to their City and suggested piggybacking off that since many municipalities would benefit. Mr. Perez informed the Board that we are in conversations with technology firms, hence, why Mr. Rodolfo's presentation was so important since people are looking at what we're doing from a technology perspective. They are seeing our City as being in the forefront.
