A Resolution of the City Commission authorizing acceptance of a Florida Department of State, Division of Arts and Culture, Specific Cultural Project Grant in the amount of \$25,000 to be put toward an outdoor temporary public art exhibition; authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Annual Budget to recognize the \$25,000 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.

The City was awarded a competitive Florida Department of State, Division of Arts and Culture, Specific Cultural Project Grant in the amount of \$25,000 to be put toward a temporary public art exhibition.

This grant requires at least one dollar in cash or in-kind (donated goods or services) for every dollar requested from the Division. Staff recommends use of Art Acquisition Fund monies to meet the requirement of matched dollars.

An amendment to the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$25,000 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.
