A Resolution accepting the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami and the City of Coral Gables; authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Annual Budget to recognize the \$59,805.63 grant as revenue, and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.

This agreement authorizes the distribution of \$59,805.63 as part of the 2017 UASI spending plan for the City of Coral Gables. The grant will provide funding to execute Homeland Security initiatives. The project identified to be funded includes Specialized Emergency Fire and Medical Services Vehicle for UASI Purchased Equipment. An amendment to the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$59,805.63 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.
