A Resolution accepting the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami and the City of Coral Gables; and authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Annual Budget to recognize the \$62,691.81 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.

This agreement authorizes the distribution of \$62,691.81 as part of the 2016 UASI spending plan for the City of Coral Gables. The grant will provide funding to execute Homeland Security initiatives. The project identified by the Fire and Police Departments to be funded include Hazardous Materials Detection Equipment, Maintenance/Sustainment/Repair/Replacement for UASI Purchased Equipment, and Mobile Message Boards to Relay Emergency Messages. An amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$62,691.81 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.
