A Resolution approving a recommendation from the Historic Preservation Board to remove the local historic designation of the vacant property at 2900 Ponce de Leon Boulevard (former site of Granada Shop and Charade Restaurant).

On October 15, 2015 the Historic Preservation Board unanimously (7 - 0) passed a motion recommending the removal of the local historic designation of the property located at 2900 Ponce de Leon Boulevard, conditioned on the placement of a descriptive plaque or other permanent feature stating the importance of the site to be incorporated in a later development of the property and to include recognition of the Wilkins family and the Granada Shop.
