A Resolution authorizing the acceptance and execution of the Florida Department of State, Division of Historical Resources Grant Award for the restoration and rehabilitation of the Coral Gables Merrick House; and authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Annual Budget to recognize the \$350,000 grant as revenue, and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the project.

On October 14, 2014 Resolution No. 2014-210 was approved by the City Commission authorizing the application of a \$350,000 grant from the Florida Department of State, Division of Historical Resources for the restoration and rehabilitation of the Coral Gables Merrick House. The resolution also authorized a City match of \$350,000 already identified and available for the Merrick House project. The grant application was approved by the state and the full \$350,000 grant has been awarded to the City.

An amendment to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 annual budget is required to recognize the \$350,000 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the project.
