Title: An Ordinance of the City Commission of Coral Gables, Florida providing for a text amendment to the City of Coral Gables Official Zoning Code, amending Article 3, "Development Review," Division 21, "Art in Public Places Program," Section 3-2103, "Art in Public Places Fund Requirements, Waivers, and Exemptions," Section 2104 "Administration," and Section 3-2105 "Enforcement,"; clarifying the ordinance by utilizing the words "alternative options" in lieu of the word "waivers," modifying procedures of the Art in Public Places Program; providing a repealer provision, severability clause, codification, and providing for an effective date.
