In furtherance of prior Commission action relating to the concerns surrounding sea level rise, this resolution directs City Staff to incorporate sea level rise concepts and considerations in approval processes and also to incorporate them into the City's Comprehensive Plan.

This follows Resolution No. 2016-223 where the Commission formally approved a white paper that laid out an overview of various sea level rise adaption policy options as well as some legal considerations and implications surrounding those policy options.
