The State of Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) has awarded the Coral Gables Police Department an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG-D) in the amount of \$10,000 to purchase fleet and motor unit equipment that will enhance security, improve access for employees and promote officer safety. The Police Department received notification that the grant application under subgrant 2019-JAGD-DADE-9-N3-097 was successfully reviewed and approved by FDLE on August 20, 2020.

An amendment to the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$10,000 grant funds as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the cost of the grant expenditures.
