## **HOUSE REPORT:** October 2014

- Total visitors in October: 7 Adults; 3 Seniors; 2 Students; 0 Youth; 0 Children; plus 51people touring during Halloween Hoedown.
- Trust Fund Balance: \$20,863 (Expenditure account); \$0 (Revenue account, pending deposit of \$2,822 from October SOTPWG event).
- Roxy O'Neal Bolton Fund: \$4,939 (unchanged).
- A Villagers grant was submitted and approved for funding.
- State of Florida Grant: Ms. Spain reported that a grant to the State of Florida for \$350,000 was submitted at the end of October to add to funds already committed by the City for the House restoration project.
- A period-appropriate headboard donation was offered by Whitney Huttig. During favorable discussion about the donation, it was agreed that the headboard could be stored in the House attic for later use.
